SYSTEM HIGHLIGHTS

- Sturdy where it counts and sleek where needed, 37 plates within 9 families address any ankle fracture personality, including intra-articular patterns
- Patented locking construct up to 30° in any direction (60° cone of angulation)
- Exclusive solutions to address malleoli fractures

DESIGN FEATURES

- Dual-lead screw options, including hexalobe 2.7 and 3.5mm locking and nonlocking cortical screws, 4.0mm locking and nonlocking cancellous screws, and partially threaded cannulated hexalobe screws
- Multi-lock functionality accepting repeatable lock and relock of screws, designed to reduce implant waste and save OR time
- Type II Anodization, Titanium Alloy
- Scalloped plate design intended for ease of plate contouring to the patient's anatomy and minimal plate footprint
